She also served as the Acting General Manager with responsibility for all operations, overseeing \$3B budget and 12000 employees. Prior to joining NYCHA, she was the global Chief Information Officer and Senior Partner of Ogilvy and Mather overseeing technology, applications, networks and data centres.

She began her career with the Metropolitan Transit Authority of New York City, where she held various progressively responsible positions over the course of 16 years, and was appointed as the Chief Information Officer with responsibilities for implementing the \$2B Metro Card project in New York City.

Her keynote presentation (http://www.worldbpoforum.com/keynote2013.aspx), titled 'Rising to the Challenge: Delivering Real Transformation' speaks to how CIOs have tremendous insight into how the organization works and where the opportunities are for transformation. Moving to the CEO role requires leading this transformation not only through the use of technology, but also through vision, passion, instinct and simply clear headed management. To lead an organization through this phase and to sell the vision requires tremendous skills like selling, persuasion, communication, and playing the power and politics.

"True transformation requires one's ability to move away from self preservation and 'now and here' mindset to thinkning 'then and there'. Only leading responsibly with compassion and thinking beyond our boundaries of time and space can help us achieve real transformation." states Ms. Riazi.
